Athletic Trainer

Position

Judson College seeks a full-time Athletic Trainer who will also serve as a Residence Hall Director. The salary range for the position is \$28,000-\$32,000, based on education and experience. On-campus room and board will be provided as additional compensation.

Qualifications

A minimum of a bachelor's degree in athletic training, NATABOC certification, and licensure by the Alabama Board of Athletic Trainers is required. A master's degree in a related field, previous coaching experience, or personal training certification is preferred. Candidates should demonstrate excellent interpersonal skills, strong communication and organizational skills, and an outstanding work ethic to be considered for this position. Candidates must also actively support the Christian mission of the institution.

Responsibilities

- Develops, coordinates, and administers a comprehensive athletic training program for intercollegiate athletics, which will include injury prevention programs, injury evaluations, injury management, injury treatment and rehabilitation, and educational programs for student-athletes.
- Coordinates, schedules, or performs, as appropriate, physical examinations and medical referrals for student-athletes to determine their ability to practice and compete.
- Provides training and consultation to head coaches related to injury prevention, concussion management, and conditioning techniques.
- Provides athletic training services for all home athletic competitions, as well as away competitions, practices, and other events as requested.
- Oversees the daily operations of the Judson College Wellness Center, providing health-related activities, information, and resources to students, employees, and community members.
- Serves as a Residence Hall Director in one of Judson's three on-campus residence halls, maintaining a safe, orderly, and positive living environment through enforcement of College policies and provision of crisis intervention, conflict negotiation, policy enforcement, and referral to other services.
- Collegially participates in College initiatives.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Context

Judson College is a private, four-year, Christian college for women in Marion, Alabama with degree programs in liberal arts, the sciences, and professional studies. For almost 180 years, Judson College has been dedicated to maturing its students into well-adjusted and productive citizens through the transmission of knowledge, the refinement of intellect, the nurturing of faith, the promotion of service, and the development of character.

In keeping with this mission, the Judson College Athletic Department seeks to help student-athletes prepare for purposeful lives by emphasizing the importance of self-discipline and hard work, cooperative effort and teamwork, strategic thinking and time management, and fair play and sportsmanship.

Judson's soccer, volleyball, basketball, softball and tennis teams compete in the South Region of the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA), Division I. Judson's equestrian teams compete in the International Horse Show Association (IHSA).
