33. Grade Point Average

Students with prior college credit must have a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) to be considered for admission to the ADN program.

34. Eligibility for License

Legal requirements for licensure in the State of Alabama are listed in the Alabama Board of Nursing Administrative Code. The Alabama Board of Nursing determines eligibility for licensure based on application reviews and authorizes candidacy to take the NCLEX-RN licensure exam.

Completed applications will be reviewed by the ADN Program Admission Panel. All applicants will be provided with written notification regarding acceptance to the ADN Program.
