



## Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting- Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

The following is posted to the Judson College website ([www.judson.edu](http://www.judson.edu)) in compliance with the reporting requirements of Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act" or the "Act"), Pub. L. No. 116-136, 134 Stat. 281 (March 27, 2020).

1. Judson College acknowledges that its duly authorized representatives signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Judson College was allocated and has received \$184,505 from the Department of Education pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. As of July 14, 2020, forty-five days beyond the distribution of funds by the Department of Education, Judson has distributed \$163,763.00 of Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of submission. In compliance with requirements of the statute, these figures will be updated quarterly going forward with the next report due by October 30, 2020 for the quarter ending September 30, 2020.
4. Judson estimates that 143 students at the institution are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
5. As of this forty-five day report, 115 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
6. Judson required its students to complete an [application](#) designed to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
7. The College provided [the linked correspondence](#) to its students informing them of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds and the process of distribution of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.
