



Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting- Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

The following is posted to the Judson College website (www.judson.edu) in compliance with the reporting requirements of Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act" or the "Act"), Pub. L. No. 116-136, 134 Stat. 281 (March 27, 2020).

1. Judson College acknowledges that its duly authorized representatives signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Judson College was allocated and has received \$184,505 from the Department of Education pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. As of March 31, 2021, Judson has distributed all \$184,505 of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. In compliance with requirements of the statute, these figures are being updated by the 10th of the month immediately following the end of each quarter. Because all of the funds from Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act have been distributed, this will serve as the final quarterly report for these funds.
4. Judson estimates that 143 students at the institution are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
5. As of the quarter ending March 31, 2021, 117 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
6. Judson required its students to complete an [application](#) designed to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
7. The College provided [the linked correspondence](#) to its students informing them of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds and the process of distribution of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.
